The Christopher Kennedy Compound: Modernism Week Show House, presented by partner and national media sponsor Traditional Home, is a must-see during the jam-packed week of annual events held to benefit Palm Springs Modernism. This year's restoration, open through February 24, takes place in an iconic midcentury ranch on Alhambra Drive originally constructed in 1962. The three-bedroom interior plan is anything but average, with four distinct outdoor spaces, an art gallery, a vibrant pool house, and a team of 14 rock-star designers who layered each space with its own unique look. Lisa McDennon, Master Closet

"When designing a closet or other functional space like this, there is a critical balance to maintain between aesthetics and function," says Lisa McDennon, who tailored the master closet. "You don't want either to be compromised." She worked with California Closets to incorporate dimmable and programmable LED strip lighting for efficient illumination around the cabinetry, while layering in crisp white Coral pendants by Hinkley Lighting and a geometric wallpaper from Kravet.
